educational and fun learning.




Emergency Stops

By 2050, 22% of the global population will be over 60 years old. And 1 in 10 people worldwide will be over 85.

Understanding the economical risk



Rapid aging has serious social and economic consequences.

An increasing share of government spending will go to funding pensions and health care for the elderly, even as the working-age population is shrinking.



Sedentary lifestyles are a leading factor of poor health

90% of the population in Romania don't do any sport and have bad nutritional habits.



The solution we have

Good health, long living



Since 2020, we are helping people stay in charge of their own lives for as long as possible as they age. We use sports to address the challenge of healthy and active aging in Romania:

- Perineum Gym
- Swimming

Poverty and food insecurity

It is hearth-breaking that in 2022, in Romania, there are still people who have no food to eat and there are zero social services for them.

Mariana, 89 years old, had only 1 jar of jam to eat in the house when we first visit her.

Now she knows help is coming her way every 3 months and will never have to go hungry to bed again.



- 20 beneficiaries
- 5 villages
- Donations every 3 months
- Covering all their basic needs

"Everything starts and ends in Education"





A project in collaboration with the county Ministry of Education that involved 12 kindergartens, 35 teachers and over 900 children.



They collected 80 kg. of bottle caps. The plastic was sold and the money was used to buy food for our vulnerable beneficiaries.



Focus learning - climate action

12 modules about recycling and climatic environment.



Focus learning - empathy and care

The children were stimulated to have empathy for the elderly, and for the poor. They find out that one simple and fun action can save someone's life.









Location: Northern Railway Station Bucharest

Period: February - July 2022



More then 20,000 refugees supported

99% Women with children



- 15.000 products donated
- 1 ton of fruits
- 300 printed stories for kids, in Ukrainian language.



- 40 volunteers over 5 months
- Thousands refugees helped with directions and information.
